Competence aims:

Learning objectives:

Experience / read about different cultures and perspectives. Talk about immigration with regards to citizenship and democracy.

Activities

Make questions for reflection and discuss in groups.

Teacher hands out pictures that students can use for discussion or for writing. Could be from the border, border patrols, the wall, Donald Trump, migrants etc.

Compare US immigration policies to the ones we have in Norway. Are they very different?

Assessment

Oral presentations in groups where they present dilemmas connected to immigration.

Or

Writing a text in the first person about a migrant experience.

Or

Make a dialogue/play/film about a scene at the border.
