Prereading activity. Book cover, title, break the title into words (part time, Indian, diary, first person narrative etc)

Read the book: Teacher reads first chapter, can also use audiobook. Time limits.
Written tasks along the way, phrased in a way that it is possible for everybody to do it.
Everybody answers according to level on teams or class notebook.

Conversation about the book. First teacher pick a passage from the book, and the pupils respond to it in class. (Modeling)

Put pupils in groups of 3 or 4 . Write topics, situations, pictures and questions from the book. Every group gets a lot of notes and talk together about them. Discussions related to ethnic groups, choice of words etc. The groups record their conversation and share it with the teacher.
